Observed holidays are noted in **RED**. Collection days that fall on or after the holiday will be delayed one day. EXCEPTION: If holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there is no change in service prior to or after the holiday.

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES



- Trash and Recycling must be curbside by 5:00 AM on your scheduled collection day, which will be remaining the same.
- No more than three (3) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 30 pounds each week.
- Yard waste must not exceed 4 feet in length, 30 pounds and must be bundled.
- Yard Waste will be collected every other week beginning in April and ending in October (see calendar above).
- Bulk items that are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted.
- No construction debris will be collected curbside.

Trash is limited to three 32-gallon trash cans or bags per week, no more than 30 pounds each. Additional cans or bags must have a YELLOW TAG (\$1.25) attached to each additional can/bag. Cans and/or bags weighing more than 30 pounds, or oversized items (e.g. sofa, mattress, or carpet) must have a RED TAG (\$4.00) attached to each. These items may be put out with your trash. Bulk items too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. No construction debris will be collected. Tags can be purchased at the township office during regular business hours.

All residents should use approved trash containers—meaning trash containers should have pre-molded handles. Fifty-five (55) gallon barrels or any barrel without handles are unacceptable trash containers as they present a safety hazard to the Penn Waste crew, and they cannot be picked up. *Containers should also have lids to keep birds and other animals out of the trash.*

Recycling is mandatory in Lancaster Township. *No recyclable materials are permitted in trash containers.* **Recycle containers** can be purchased at the township office—\$10.00 each. If you wish to buy your own container, be sure it is clearly marked **RECYCLING**.

Recyclable materials will be picked up each week on the same day that trash is collected. Please put your recycling container out only when it is full. This is a **co-mingled recycling program**. (*Electronic waste cannot be put out for recycling.*) The following items are recyclable and should be *thoroughly cleaned* and placed inside your *recycling container*:

- *PLASTIC*—#1 through #7 (soda and water bottles, milk jugs, etc.)
- *GLASS*—clear, brown, blue, green, glass food and beverage containers
- *METAL*—aluminum beverage cans, steel food and beverage cans, aerosol cans, and paint cans
- *PAPER, PAPERBOARD, CARDBOARD*—All sizes of cardboard boxes (breakdown boxes as flat as possible), clean pizza boxes, food boxes (e.g. cereal & gelatin boxes), empty paper towel/toilet paper rolls, paperboard packaging (e.g. tissue boxes), office paper (any color), newspapers/inserts, magazines/catalogs/brochures, envelopes, junk mail, paper bags, phone books, soft cover books, paperboard food and drink cartons.
- *CORRUGATED CARDBOARD*— Break down boxes as flat as possible and put them out next to your recycling bin. Corrugated cardboard may also be taken to the township maintenance facility at 1357 Meadowcreek Lane and deposited into the cardboard dumpster.

Check the weather. If the weather calls for high winds or rain, keep recycling inside until the following week, if possible. Wet cardboard products are more difficult to process.

Both trash & recycling must be curbside by 5:00AM on your scheduled collection day.

Holiday Refuse Collection

Penn Waste observes the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. If a collection day falls on a holiday, collection for the week will be delayed by one day.
