**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LANCASTER, ORDINANCE 2014-04, CHAPTER 229 OF THE
CODE OF LANCASTER TOWNSHIP, TO AMEND SECTION 229-21-DEFINITIONS**

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Background: The Board of Supervisors of Lancaster Township adopted a Stormwater Management Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2014-04 on April 14, 2014, said Ordinance being codified in Chapter 229 of the Code of Lancaster Township.

The Board of Supervisors of Lancaster Township has determined that the Stormwater Management Ordinance, in particular Section 229-21-Definitions, should be revised.

Accordingly, the Board of Supervisors of Lancaster Township has determined that the following revisions should be made.

1. Section 229-21 – Definitions –Environmentally Sensitive Area is amended to read as follows:


Slopes greater than 15%, shallow bedrock (located within six feet of ground surface), species of concern (core habitat), riparian forest buffer, parks and open space, natural communities, interior forests, 100 year floodplain, forest block, wetlands, and other areas as determined by the Zoning Officer.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lancaster as provided by law.
