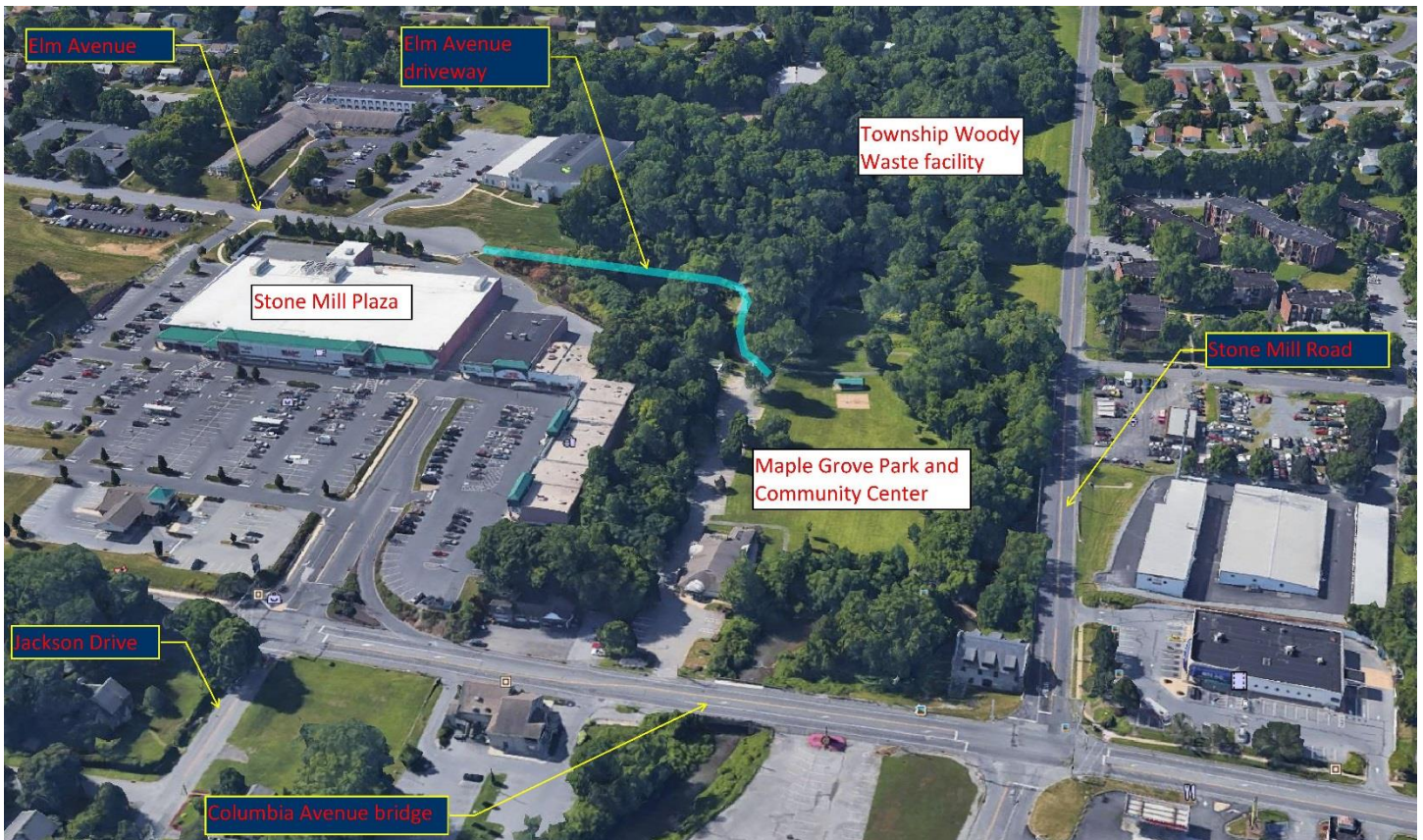


## **Notification to users of Maple Grove Community Center and Woody Waste facility**

PennDOT's Columbia Avenue Bridge Replacement project – January 23, 2018



At last report, PennDOT's work on this project is likely to begin in June 2018 and end in February 2019. Once completed, the bridge will have the same two travel lanes and center turning lane with new eight-foot wide shoulders and five-foot wide sidewalks on each side of the bridge.

We expect that there will be impacts to traffic, with one lane in each direction open during daylight hours. From time to time, there may be a need to close the bridge completely during overnight hours only. Between now and June, utility relocation work will continue with little to no anticipated impact on traffic.

During the second half of the construction period, PennDOT will be closing our driveway into the Community Center from Columbia Avenue. Traffic will be detoured to Elm Avenue. Directional signage and a temporary signal at each end of the driveway will be installed for way-finding and safe entry to the Elm Avenue driveway. This driveway is narrow and cannot accommodate two-way traffic. We suggest that you allow for ten additional minutes of travel time for the first few times that you need to enter the driveway from Elm Avenue.

Users of the Woody Waste facility will need to enter via the Elm Avenue driveway and then exit onto Meadowcreek Lane.

PennDOT is working out the details for the temporary signal, which will be shared when available.

Lancaster Township will continue working with PennDOT to have up-to-date information regarding scheduled construction activities and impacts to our community.
