Dear Resident,

Lancaster Township has a continuous road maintenance plan for the upkeep of all township roads and alleys. It is important that our roads are properly maintained in order to avoid much more costly repairs or replacement due to neglect. *Your street or alley is included in the 2020 paving schedule.*

Paving takes place between July 1st and August 15th on the following:

In Alleys all plantings, trees, shrubs and flowers must be removed from the public Right-of-Way **before April 30, 2020.**

Trees overhanging the public roads or alleys from your property must be elevated to a minimum of 18 feet above the road surface. The Township has contracted to have this work done beginning after April 30th.

Any obstructions placed within the Alley right-of-way that you wish to save must be moved prior to April 30th, of 2020. This includes bushes, trees flowerbeds, etc. The Public Works Department will be staking the alley to identify where the right of way limits are.

Road width and approximate Right-of-Way widths from the centerline of the road can be found on the township website under the *Street (Road) Opening Permits* page -

If plantings and or obstructions remain after April 30th, they will be removed by the Township Public Works Department or our sub-contractors.

If you anticipate upgrades or changes to your water, sewer, electrical or gas service, or if you are planning driveway resurfacing, etc., you should arrange to **have all of these completed before July 1, 2020.**

All utilities have been notified of the township paving plan for 2020.

During the actual paving days you will experience some inconvenience:

- **No Parking on street or alley during the days of milling or paving**
- **Street and Alley closed for several hours on paving days**

You will be notified of specific paving days for your road at least 48 hours in advance.
