

**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-02
FOR STREET REGULATORY SIGNAGE**

**THE TOWNSHIP OF LANCASTER
LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LANCASTER, LANCASTER COUNTY
PENNSYLVANIA TO AMEND CHAPTER 263 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO
DESIGNATE MAPLE AVENUE FROM ABBEYVILLE ROAD TO PERRY
AVENUE AS TWO-WAY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C. S. Section 6109(a) and (b), a local municipal corporation is authorized to regulate speed limits on certain roadways within the municipal boundaries and to regulate stopping, standing and parking, to designate certain intersections as stop intersections, and to post appropriate signage regulating speed, parking and stopping;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 263 of the Code of the Township of Lancaster, Article I, Section 263-2, all traffic and parking regulations within the Township are to be enacted by ordinance or amendments to ordinances;

WHEREAS, at the request of the Township, its engineer Ben Webber prepared a regulatory study as was warranted by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Devices, to designate locations for installation of appropriate signage regulating stopping at certain intersections and parking; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to establish and enforce the direction and limits of one-way vehicular travel on Township streets and roadways, to establish the location of and to enforce stop signs, and to establish and enforce parking restrictions within the Township;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1. Section 263-13 of the Township Code is hereby amended to change the limits of one-way vehicular travel on Maple Avenue from Atkins Avenue to Abbeyville Road to be from Atkins Avenue to Perry Avenue.
2. Chapter 263, Article II, Section 263-17 of the Township Code is hereby amended to add to the list of stop intersections Maple Avenue at Perry Avenue (stop sign to be erected along Maple Avenue)

3. Chapter 263, Article III, Section 263-25.F of the Township Code is hereby amended to add Maple Avenue (north side) from Abbeyville Road to Perry Avenue to the list of established “No Parking” zones on streets of parts thereof within the Township.

4. This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Manheim Township Police Department or any other authorized police officer in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania and the Township Code for Lancaster Township as each pertain to enforcement, fines and other penalties.

5. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of the provisions thereof shall be found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions conflicting or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed but only insofar as sane are in direct conflict or directly inconsistent with this Ordinance.

7. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of its enactment.
